RESOLUTION NO. 3212

A RESOLUTION VACATING MAIN STREET NORTH, FROM 47TH AVE NORTH TO A POINT 600 FEET NORTH OF 47TH AVE NORTH, BETWEEN FLICKERTAIL ADDITION, LOTS 11-16 AND 31-36; AND 47TH AVE NE, BETWEEN MAIN STREET NORTH AND 1ST STREET NE AND BETWEEN FLICKERTAIL ADDITION, LOTS 36 & 37

WHEREAS, the owners of all the property abutting on that part of the above described street duly petitioned the City Council of the City of Minot for the vacation thereof, and

WHEREAS, the petition was in all things legal and proper and complied with the provisions of Chapter 40-30 of the North Dakota Century Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Council received said petition and ordered the same to be filed with the City Clerk and directed the giving of notice by publication in the Minot Daily News, official newspaper of the city of Minot, for four weeks, which notice provided that the petition would be heard and considered by the City Council in the City Council Chambers at City Hall on the 1st day of July, 2013, at 6:30 p.m., and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has approved said vacation as not being inconsistent with the master plan for street development or improvement, and said Planning Commission having made its report to the City Council favoring the granting of said petition stated, which report is now on file with the City Clerk; and the City Council having duly examined and considered the report and petition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Minot, that the petition be granted, and that said property sought to be vacated by, and the same is hereby vacated, and the property formerly occupied by said property shall vest in the abutting owners in accordance with law.
