We then went into the bills and John Jacobson, Legislative Committee Chairman went through the bills that had been introduced and we addressed each one as to our support or not.

SB2007 Budget for VA and Home voted to support.

SB2062 Passed and sent to House

SB2073 Passed and sent to House

SB 2120 Passed in Senate relating to parking privileges for disabled veterans. Moved by Dan. S. and seconded by Dave R. and passed VCC.

SB 2122 Passed in Senate relating to best interests and welfare of the child factors and limitations on post judgement. Emery F moved to support Dale R. seconded and it was approved.

SB 2127 Passed in Senate relating to private employers providing veteran's preference. Dave J moved to support and Dale R. seconded the motion and it was approved.

SB 2201 relating to school district employment preferences for veterans. Dan S moved to not support. Did not get the second, but it was voted to not support.

SB 2210: A bill for an act to provide for the publishing of a book on ND Veterans who died in service. Steve Volk moved to support as amended Dan. S seconded the motion and it was approved.

SB 2242 relating to hunting and fishing fees for disabled veterans died for a lack of a motion

SB 2253: Relating to property tax exemption for the primary residence of a certain military service members. Emery F. moved to support with Jim H. seconding the motion and it was approved.

SB 2264: An appropriation to the Adj Gen. for veteran's military caskets. Sen. Marcellais spoke on this bill and showed us information on this bill. Support following N. G.

SB 2286: Indian Veteran representative for reservation, no support for lack of a motion.

SB 2296 relating to an increase in the amount of valuation covered by the disabled veteran's credit. Mark L. moved to support and Dave R. seconded the motion and it was approved.

SB 2344: To provide an appropriation for training service dogs and provide for a legislative mgmt. study. Dave J. moved to support and Steve V. seconded the motion and it was approved.

SCR 4008: Cold War Victory Day. Jim Y. moved to support and Dave R. seconded the motion and it was approved.

We also discussed the concurrent resolution arms treaty and Emery F moved to support and Dave J seconded the motion and it was approved.

Lonnie spoke on the VSO bill and the senate say no cash for VSO, but there are options and we can do amendments to still maybe get this money.

Col. French spoke on SB2205 and HB 1293 both NG. Bills
