- 1) The Applicant must be either a Veteran as Defined in NDCC 37-14-01.1 or an un-remarried widow/widower of an eligible veteran.

37-14-01.1. Definition of a veteran. As used in this chapter, “veteran” means an individual who served in the armed forces of the United States on federal active duty for reasons other than training and who has been discharged under other than dishonorable conditions.

- 2) The applicant must have the financial ability to repay the loan.

- 3) The applicant must be a resident of North Dakota for one year prior to date of application.
 - A. Correctional and/or Correctional Treatment Facility.
 - 1.) Applicants must provide proof of one year North Dakota residency prior to entering a correctional and/or correctional treatment facility.

 - 2.) Time spent in the facility does not count toward residency.

 - 3.) Applicants who are held in a correctional and/or correctional treatment facility are not eligible for a loan.
