

In Person Level 2 Proofing Process For the Veteran

You must provide approved identity documents in-person at the time you request a Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC).

1. One primary form of government-issued photo identification and one secondary form of identification
2. Or two primary forms of identification.

No other combination is permitted. Consult the "Primary ID Documents Accepted" and "Secondary ID Documents Accepted" sections below for a list of acceptable document types.

ADDRESS CONFIRMATION DOCUMENT CRITERIA

If your primary or secondary forms of ID do not contain your current address, the following documents have been designated as being acceptable proof. Your name must be the addressee on the document, and the document must be postmarked or dated within the last 30 days. Envelopes by themselves are not acceptable.

Acceptable Documents to Verify a Veteran's Addresses

1. Phone bill from a local phone service provider
2. Electric bill from a local electrical service provider
3. Fossil fuel (oil, gas, propane) bill from a local service provider
4. Credit card statement
5. Checking or savings account statement
6. Local personal property tax bill
7. Mortgage or rent payment voucher
8. Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA) document or letter reflecting the correct mailing address.
