TESTIMONY BEFORE BUDGET SECTION MEDICAID SYSTEMS PROJECT UPDATE SEPTEMBER 22, 2010

Chairman Holmberg, members of the Budget Section, I am Jenny Witham, Director of the Information Technology Services Division for the Department of Human Services (DHS). I appear before you to provide information on the budget of the Medicaid Systems Project and Medicaid claims processing.

At the June 22, 2010 Budget Section, Tom Burlin, Chief Operating Officer public sector portfolio of ACS, testified in regards to the revised go-live date of June 1, 2012. Since that time the Department has successfully completed and accepted all revised detailed work plans and is in the process of revising the integrated work plan for the new go-live date. We have submitted to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) the updated Implementation Advanced Planning Document. Included in this submission were the revised contracts for the third party vendors, and we continue to work toward the finalization of the cost negotiations with ACS. Once completed, the ACS contract will also require submission to CMS for final approval.

The table on the next page outlines the expenditures through the month of August 2010.
