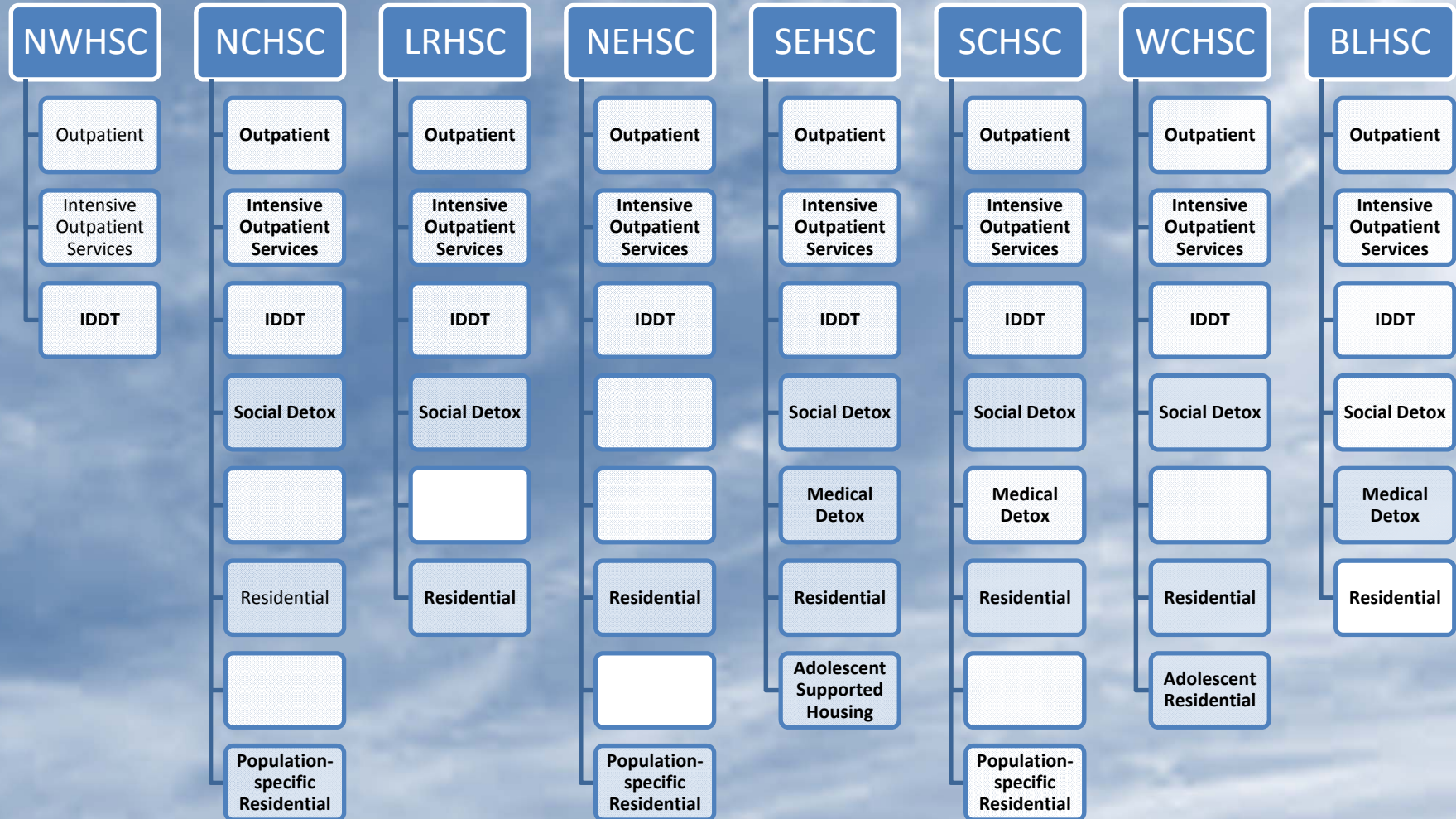
SUD Service Snapshot

- **Eight Regional Human Service Centers**
 - SUD Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient Treatment for adolescents and adults
 - Integrated Dual Disorders Treatment
 - Contract for multiple residential levels of care
- **North Dakota State Hospital**
 - Medically Monitored and Medically Managed Intensive Inpatient Services
 - Clinically Managed Population Specific High Intensity Residential Services for men and women in the custody of the Department of Corrections

SUD Staffing Snapshot

- **Eight Regional Human Service Centers**
 - 81 Licensed Addiction Counselors
 - 20 LAC for Adolescent Services
 - 61 LAC for Adult Services
- **North Dakota State Hospital**
 - 13 Licensed Addiction Counselors
 - 1 Addiction Technician
 - 70 other staff, including psychiatrists, nurse practitioners, licensed social workers, nurses, and various psychosocial rehabilitative staff

18,692 individuals received at least one recorded service at an HSC

11,686 individuals received ongoing service in an identified program of care

191 clients receiving IDDT services

2,985 SUD adults enrolled and receiving services

245 SUD youth enrolled and receiving services

84 NDSH SUD admissions to Tompkins Rehabilitation Center

119 NDSH admissions to medically managed SUD services
