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# Regional Emergency Response

homeland for all North Dakotans*

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The North Dakota Department of Emergency Services (NDDDES), with funding provided by the US Department of Homeland Security, developed a regional response plan that will serve all of the people of North Dakota with an effective response to a human-caused, technological, or natural event.

**CONCEPT:** The Anchor Capability Regional Response Concept is a method through which emergency response resources for a catastrophic event are identified and collectively used throughout a particular region. Regional efforts to quantify and coordinate these resources greatly enhance our ability to respond to threats and hazards.


**VISION:** An Integrated regional response throughout North Dakota

**MISSION:** Regional coordinators will facilitate, coordinate, develop, educate, plan, and promote regional response for a safer and more secure public.

Not all fire districts, cities, or counties can afford to train and staff Haz Mat teams, SWAT teams, or Bomb Squads, but North Dakota citizens, no matter where they live, deserve coordinated response to threats and hazards. By using the regional response model, along with adequate response capability, appropriate response will be delivered across North Dakota.

A comprehensive plan has been developed for regional response within core capability parameters. Regional advisory and technical committees are utilized to make recommendations to the NDDDES Policy Network to assist in determining the best utilization of homeland security allocations to enhance defined targeted areas with a regional response nexus. The work in ongoing and continues to progress.
