



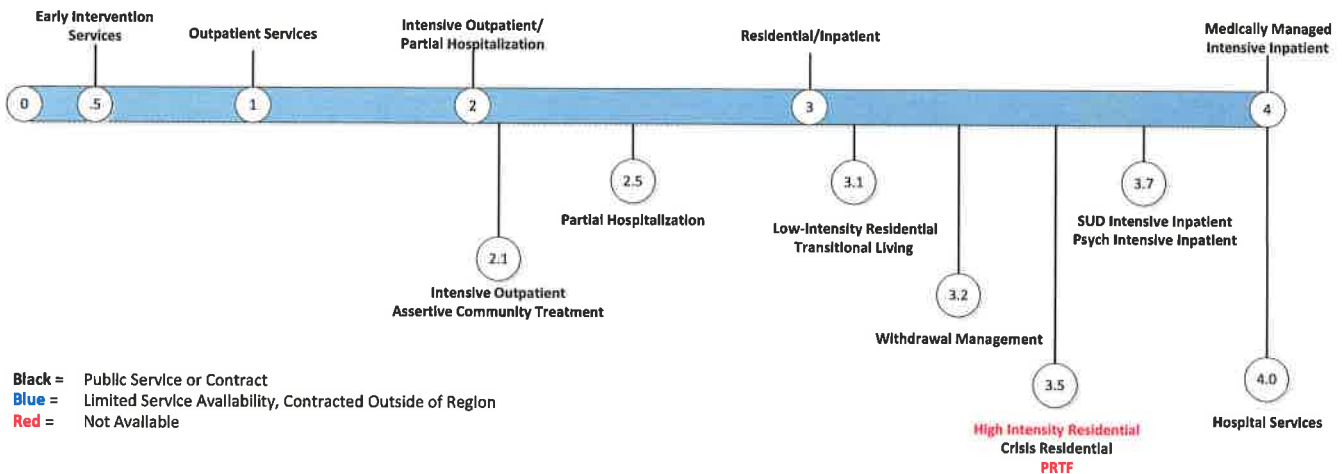

Open Access

- Completed Tasks
 - Initial training and consultation with contracted consultant
 - Open Access started
 - As of Dec. 31, 2016:
 - 624 individuals have been triaged
 - 361 have received evaluation (246 Addiction & 115 Mental Health)
 - 52 of these were priority cases (IV drug usage and/or pregnant)
