## **Statewide Independent Living Council to Meet Nov. 13-14 in Fargo**

BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota’s Statewide Independent Living Council will meet Thursday, Nov. 13, 2014, from 1 to 5 p.m. and Friday, Nov. 14, from 9 a.m. to noon at the Doublewood Inn, 3333 13th Ave. S., Fargo, N.D. The public is welcome to participate in the meeting.

The council meets quarterly and leads independent living network efforts to develop resources and to advocate for full community participation of North Dakotans with disabilities.

Council members will hear reports from subcommittees and will discuss the progress on the State Plan for Independent Living. Directors of the centers for independent living will provide reports and will discuss issues important to people with disabilities that may emerge during the 2015 legislative session. A representative of the Great Plains Food Bank will share information about their veteran’s outreach program.
