State Council on Developmental Disabilities to meet Dec. 10

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota State Council on Developmental Disabilities will meet Thursday, Dec. 10, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Central Time, at multiple video conference sites across the state to continue work on its 2015-2021 State Plan and to receive reports on council activities and its budget.

The council will also meet in executive session to review the small grant requests it received previously and the initial scoring completed on those grant requests by the Executive Committee in November.
