Williston human service center's advisory group to meet Feb. 3

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Human Services' Northwest Human Service Center (NWHSC) advisory group will hold its quarterly meeting on Feb. 3, from 12 to 1 p.m., Central Time, at the center at 316 Second Ave. W. in Williston. The meeting is open to the public.

Staff will provide updates on the center's operations and staffing. Clinical Director Tammy Ness will report on Open Access behavioral health assessments. In November, the center began offering mental health and addiction assessments without appointments Tuesdays through Thursdays, between 8 a.m. and 11 a.m.

Advisory group members who represent Divide, McKenzie, and Williams counties will have an opportunity to share information about local needs and to make recommendations for planning, funding, and the provision of services in the region.
