Northeast Human Service Center hosts regional advisory group meeting on June 20

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Human Services' Northeast Human Service Center (NEHSC) is holding its regional advisory group meeting on Monday, June 20, from 4:30 to 6 p.m., at the center at 151 S. Fourth St. in Grand Forks.

Advisory group members who represent Grand Forks, Nelson, Pembina, and Walsh counties will receive updates on behavioral health and other human services. Members are encouraged to provide local updates and to make recommendations about meeting local needs.

The meeting agenda includes a presentation on child care by staff member Lisa Hillesland. Regional human service center director Kate Kenna and her staff will brief advisory group members on human resources at the center, Fair Labor Standards Act changes, the detox center, the electronic health record project, county office building upgrades, a video about the center that is under development, the center's 2015-2017 budget, and the recent Interim Human Services Committee Meeting held on site in mid-May.
