BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota Department of Human Services offices in Fargo will delay opening until 1 p.m. today, Feb. 22, due to hazardous conditions.

Offices affected by the delayed opening include Southeast Human Service Center and the regional vocational rehabilitation and child support offices in Fargo.
