Human Services' direct client service locations in Bismarck and Dickinson will be closed tomorrow, April 12 due to forecasted blizzard

BISMARCK, N.D. – Several North Dakota Department of Human Services offices that provide direct client services will be closed tomorrow, April 12, due to the forecasted blizzard that will cause dangerous weather conditions.

IMPORTANT: People experiencing a behavioral health crisis should call 211 for immediate help.

The crisis line is available 24-hours a day, seven days a week.

AFFECTED OFFICES:

Bismarck region: West Central Human Service Center and the regional vocational rehabilitation office in Bismarck will be closed tomorrow, April 12.

Dickinson region: Badlands Human Service Center in Dickinson and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Dickinson will be closed tomorrow, April 12.

Office closure decisions are made for the safety of clients and staff and align with closures of other community clinics and government organizations.

The department will determine tomorrow if additional human service centers and offices will close due to the dangerous weather conditions. Weather-related office closure information can be found on the department's [Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#) pages.
