WEATHER-RELATED ANNOUNCEMENT: 6:40 p.m. CT Update

Human Services' offices in Grand Forks and Grafton will delay opening until noon tomorrow, April 13; several other direct client services locations are closed tomorrow

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Human Services' offices Grand Forks and satellite office in Grafton will delay opening until noon tomorrow, April 13, due to hazardous weather conditions.

Earlier today, the department announced that several other offices that provide direct client services in Bismarck, Devils Lake, Dickinson, Jamestown, Minot, Rolla, Valley City and Williston will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

IMPORTANT: People experiencing a behavioral health crisis should call 211 for immediate help. The crisis line is available 24-hours a day, seven days a week.

IMPACTED OFFICES:

NEW - Grand Forks/Grafton region: Northeast Human Service Center in Grand Forks, its satellite office in Grafton and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Grand Forks will delay opening until noon tomorrow, April 13.

Bismarck region: West Central Human Service Center in Bismarck and the regional vocational rehabilitation office in Bismarck will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

Devils Lake/Rolla region: Lake Region Human Service Center in Devils Lake, its satellite office in Rolla, and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Devils Lake will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

Dickinson region: Badlands Human Service Center in Dickinson and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Dickinson will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

Jamestown/Valley City region: South Central Human Service Center in Jamestown, its satellite office in Valley City, and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Jamestown will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

Minot region: North Central Human Service Center in Minot and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Minot will be closed tomorrow, April 13.

Williston region: Northwest Human Service Center in Williston and the regional child support and vocational rehabilitation offices in Williston will be closed tomorrow, April 13.
