Public Comment Sought on North Dakota State Council on Developmental Disabilities 5 Year State Plan 2012-2016

The North Dakota State Council on Developmental Disabilities is seeking public comments on its 2012-2016 State Plan draft. The state plan guides the Council through the requirements in the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act of 2000 (PL 106-402) (the DD Act). The purpose of this Act is to make sure people with developmental disabilities and their families take part in the design of and have access to needed community services, supports, and other forms of assistance. This helps promote self-determination, independence, productivity, and integration and inclusion in all facets of community life, through culturally competent programs.
