Public Comment Sought on the Renewal of the Medicaid 1915(c) Traditional Individual with Intellectual Disabilities/Developmental Disabilities (IID/DD) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Waiver Application

November 1, 2013

The North Dakota Department of Human Services' Developmental Disabilities Division is seeking public comment on the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Traditional IID/DD waiver renewal application. This notice is open for comment for the next 30 days.

The Traditional IID/DD waiver serves people with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities and includes an array of home and community-based services in the least restrictive environment. The current Traditional IID/DD waiver is approved for five years and expires March 31, 2014.

In the renewal application, changes have been made in Appendix C: Environmental Modifications, Equipment & Supplies, In-home Supports and Transportation for Financially Responsible Caregivers. In addition changes were made to the performance measures in the appendices to comply with federal regulations.
