WHEREAS, in North Dakota, children are provided support needed to thrive physically, emotionally and socially by foster parents working as a team with social services and other professionals; and


WHEREAS, North Dakotans are known for their compassion and have a long-standing tradition of opening their hearts and homes to children in need of a stable and caring environment; and

WHEREAS, dedicated foster families frequently adopt foster children who cannot return to their birth families, resulting in a greater need for more foster families; and


WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the valuable and continuing contributions of foster parents who show their love and support continuously; and
