

## Discrimination Prohibited.

## What is the Crossroads Program?

### **CROSSROADS PROVIDES:**

- **Transportation**  
Help with Transportation costs
- **Child Care**  
Waived co-payment under the Child Care Assistance Program
- **Case Management**
  - Parenting Skills
  - Housing
  - Goal Setting
  - Child care selection
  - Decision making
- **Educational Incentive**  
Incentive payment for achieving goals
- **Graduation Incentive**  
Incentive payment upon completion of high school or GED



### Who Qualifies?

- Teen parents may be eligible through the month the teen parent turns 21 years of age
- Teen parents who are male or female
- Teen parents who are married or unmarried
- Teen parents who reside with and have the primary responsibility for the care of their child
- Teen parents who are working towards completing their education

**Crossroads does not consider assets or income when determining eligibility.**

## How Do I Apply?

Complete a Crossroads Program application and submit it to one of the these locations:

If requesting help with child care you must also fill out a Child Care Assistance Program application and must meet all other program eligibility criteria.
