Developmental Work Activity Center (DWAC)**

Summary of Services:

The Developmental Work Activity Center (DWAC) provides day support services for 50 adult individuals with developmental disabilities. The supports are many and varied but center around providing training and meaningful work experiences for those individuals who choose to work, but need a structured environment with staff support and reinforcement. DWAC works with over 100 area businesses each year supporting them in various tasks that they choose to contract out. The work can be accomplished by crews working in the community or it can be completed at DWAC. Examples of the work produced include janitorial services, packaging of various products, assembly of small or large item, preparing various items for bulk mailings, etc.
