### Summary of Services:

Child Protection Assessments, Child Protection Case Management, Child Fatality Review Panel, Institutional Child Protection, Children's Trust Fund, Child Abuse and Prevention.

Parent Aide, Prime Time, Intensive In-Home, Respite Care, Family Focus, Safety/Permanency Funds.

Licensing, Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R), Tribal Consult, and Head Start.
