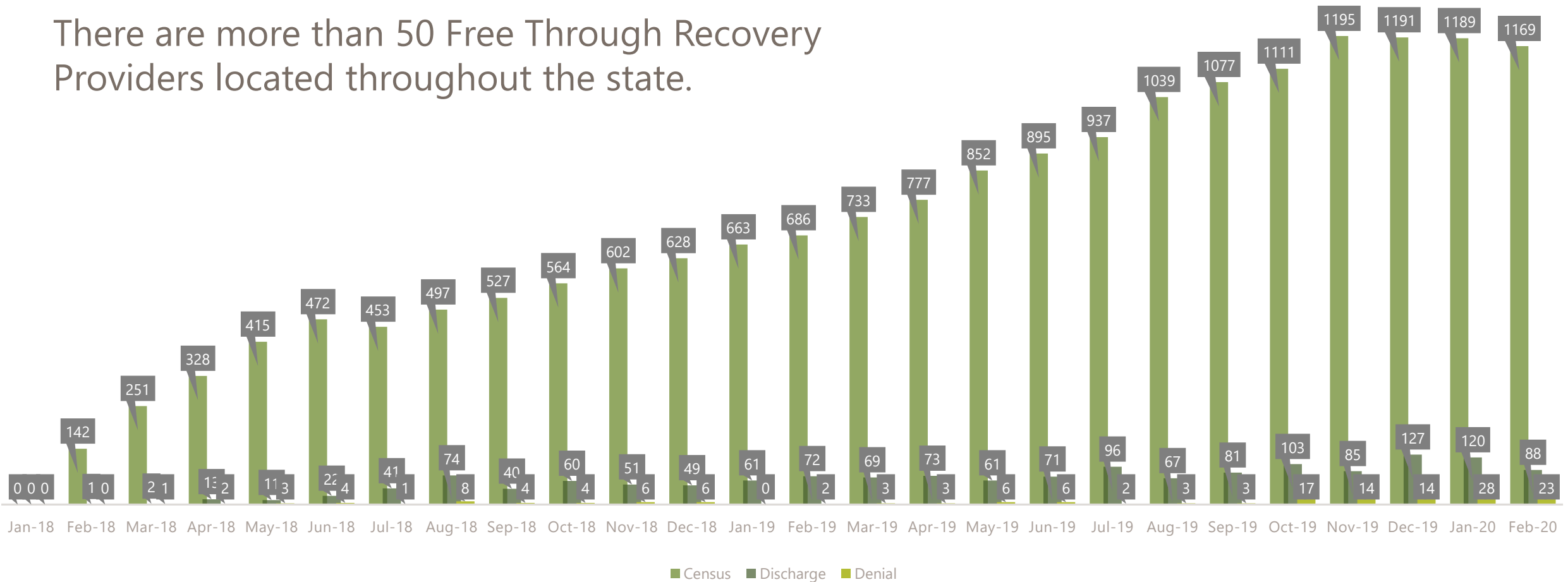

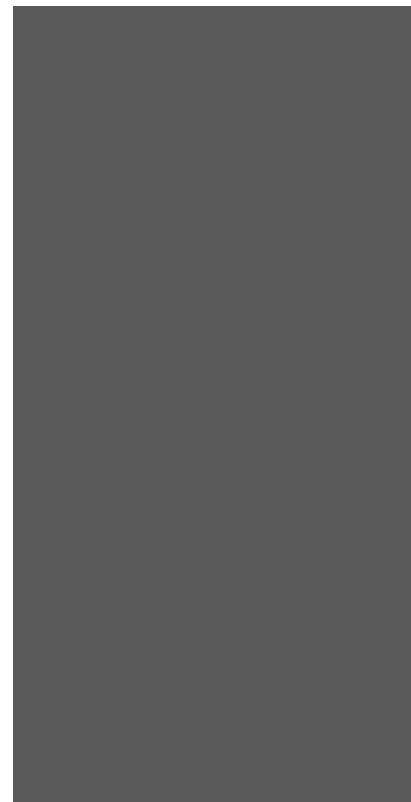
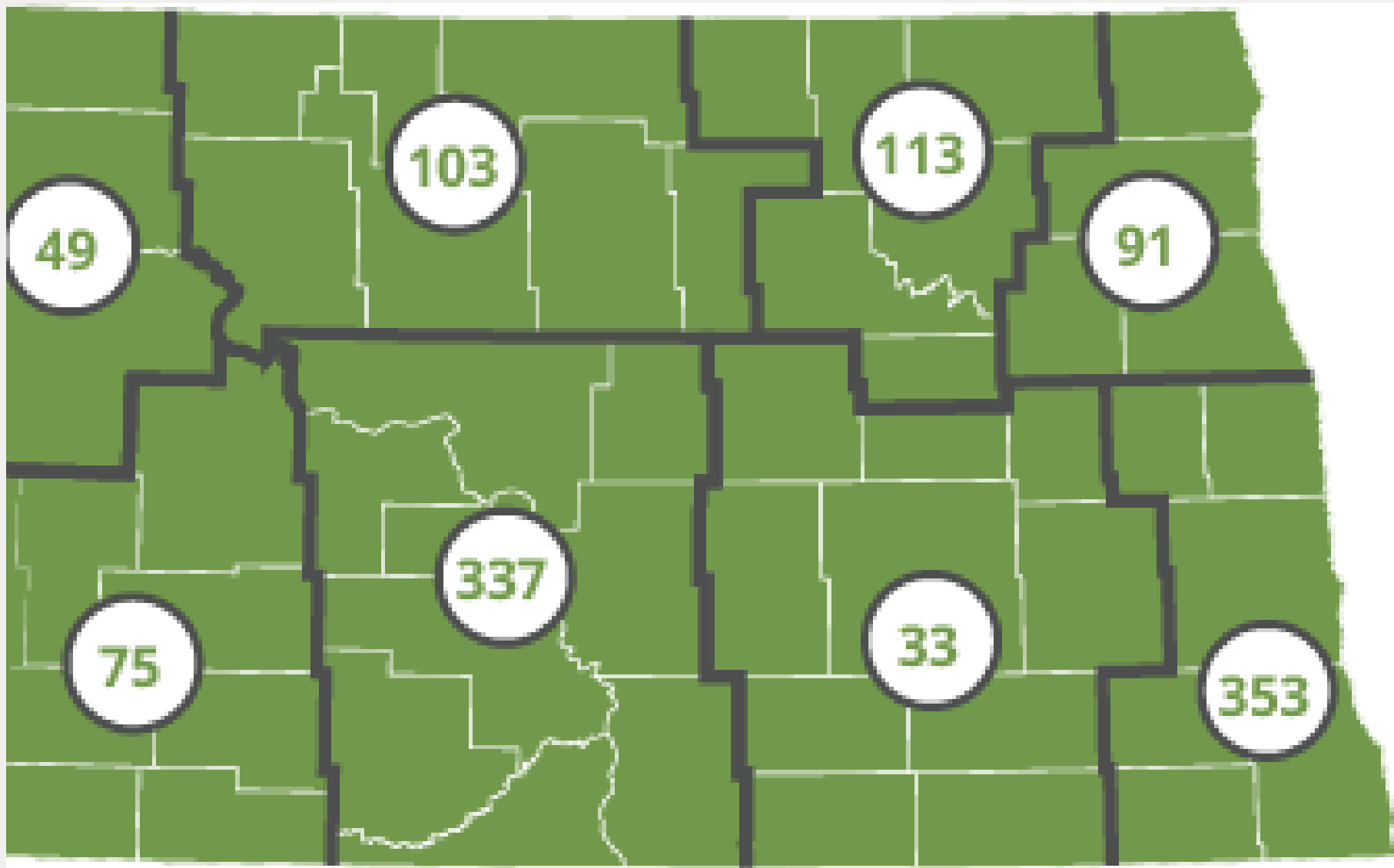
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IMPLEMENTATION

Behavioral Health Needs

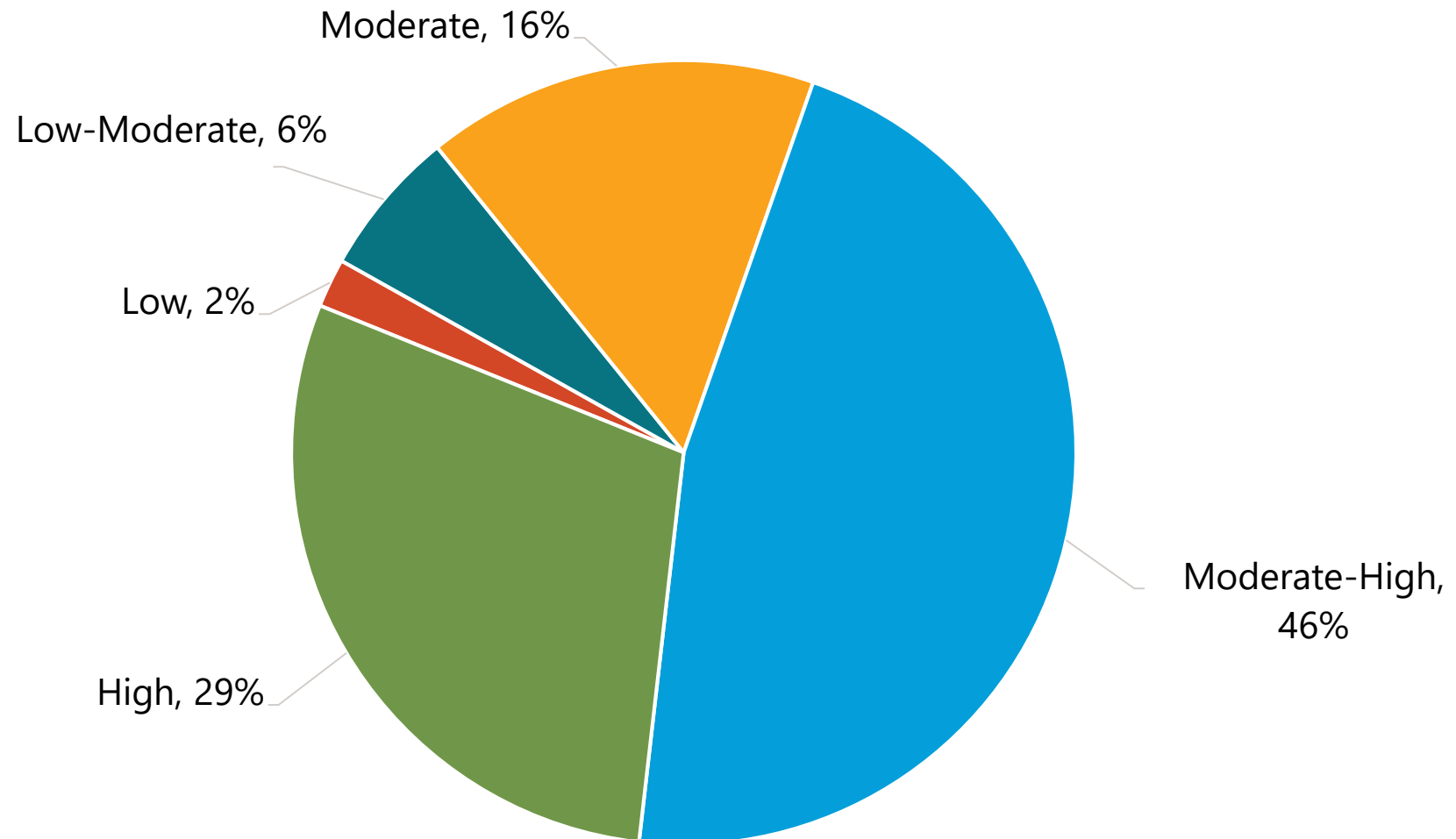


- Co-Occurring - **46%**
- Substance Use - **43%**
- Mental Health - **11%**

OF THE 1,169 CURRENT PARTICIPANTS:

- 46% of participants have a co-occurring (mental health and substance use) behavioral health need.
- 62% of participants are male.
- Half of the participants (57%) are between the ages of 31-50 and a third (33%) of the individuals are between the ages of 18-30.
- The majority (64%) of participants are white. 26% of participants are Native American.
- 75% of participants have a moderate-high or high risk of committing new crimes (LSI-R score of 30 or above).
- The majority of current participants in the program come from the Fargo area (31%), followed by Bismarck (29%).

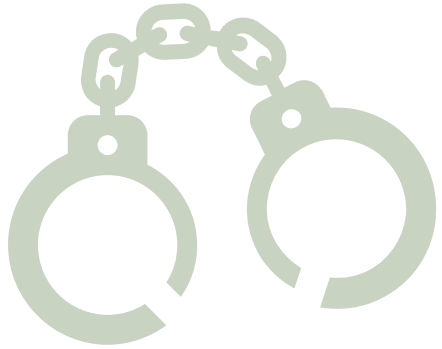
Free Through Recovery
Providers are reimbursed with a pay for performance model. In addition to monthly base pay, providers can receive performance pay if participants meet at least 3 of 4 outcome metrics (Housing, Employment, Recovery, and Involvement with Law Enforcement).

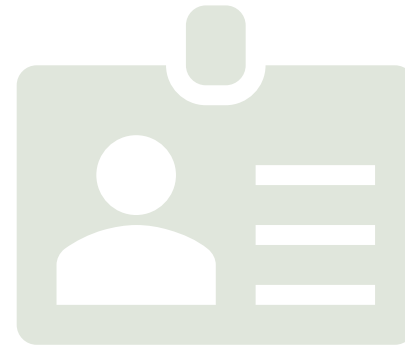

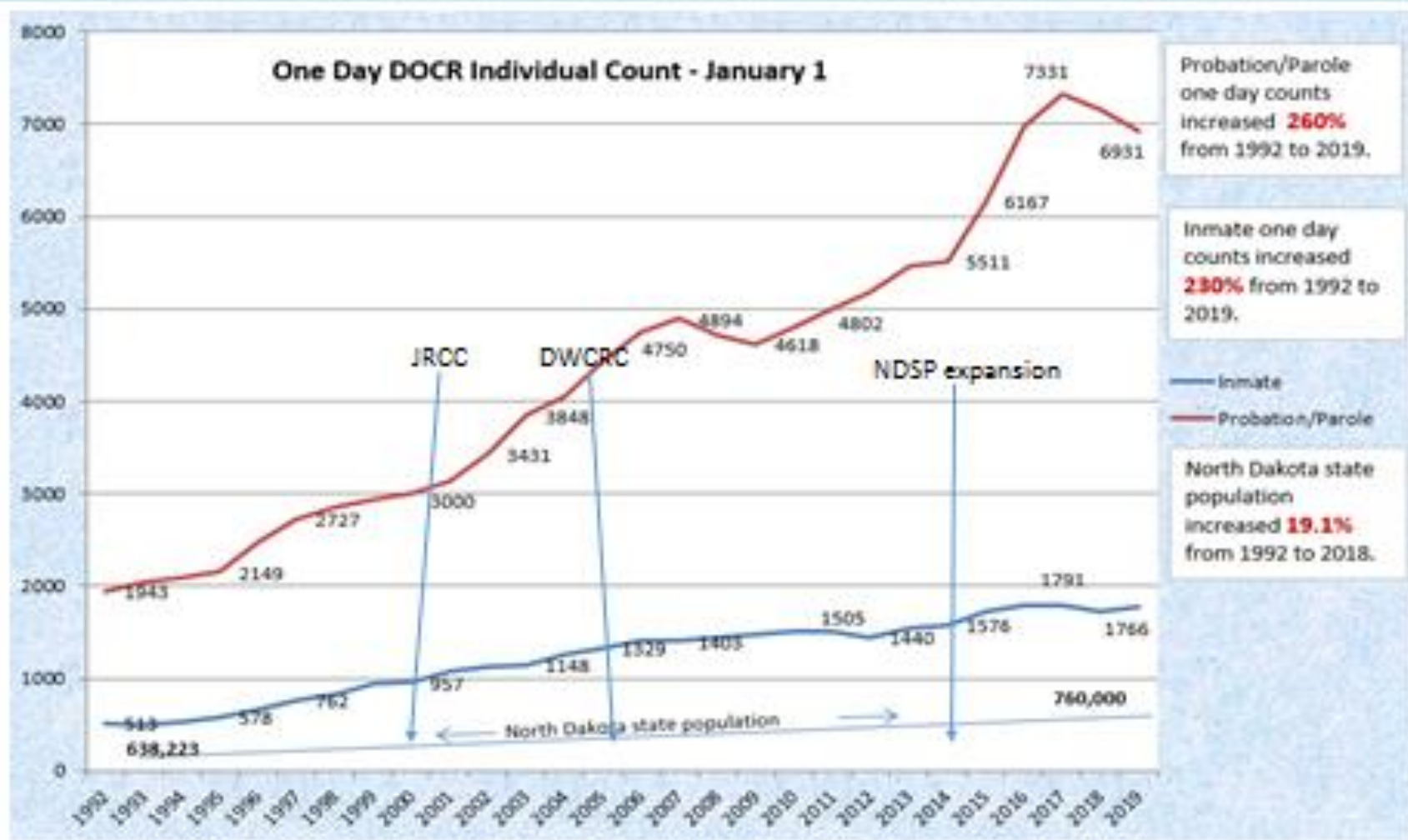
