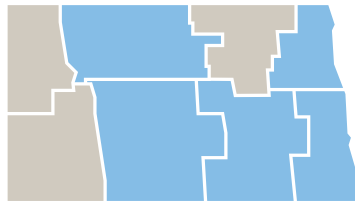


Access to Three Levels of Residential Care and 311 Beds

Locations: Northeast, West Central, South Central, Southeast and North Central Regions

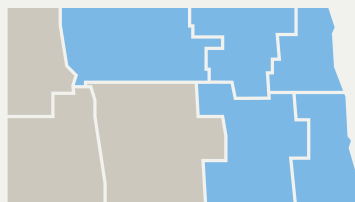
Who is served: Individuals with severe mental illness and substance use disorders.

Treatment focus: Residential treatment to assist individuals in learning housekeeping, hygiene and employment skills sufficient to move progressively into independent living.

Length of stay: Short term, approximately 51 days on average.

Locations: Lake Region, Northeast, North Central, South Central and Southeast Regions

Who is served: Individuals with severe substance use or dual disorders.

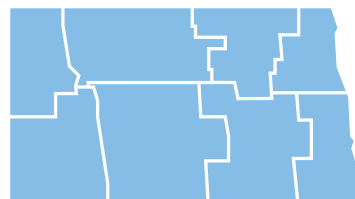
Treatment focus: Residential treatment to assist individuals in attaining physical and emotional stability in a semi-controlled environment.

Length of stay: Goal is to achieve early remission, approximately 22 days on average.

8 Crisis Stabilization
Facilities

All eight locations have dedicated first responder drop-off areas



Locations: All Eight Human Service Centers

Who is served: Individuals in mental health or substance use crisis.

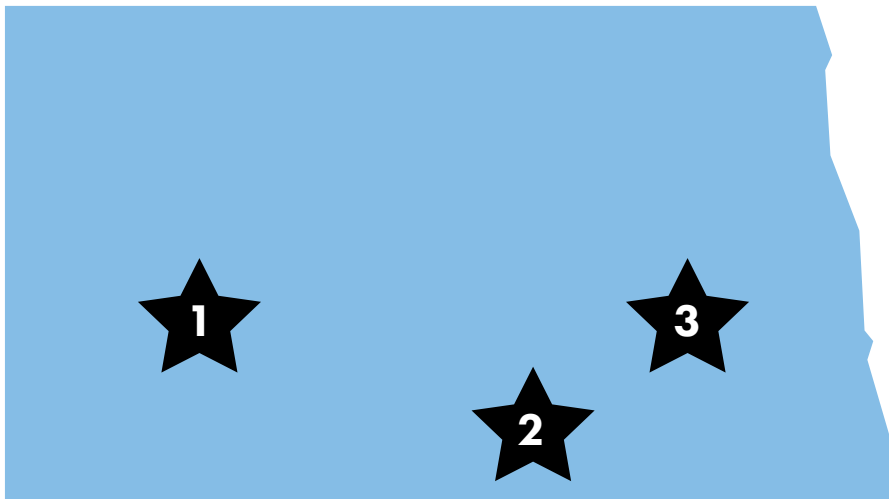
Treatment focus: 24 hour crisis receiving and stabilization facility; assessment and/or support for medical stability while in the facility.

Length of stay: Approximately 7 days on average.
