# Shelter Care and Respite Care

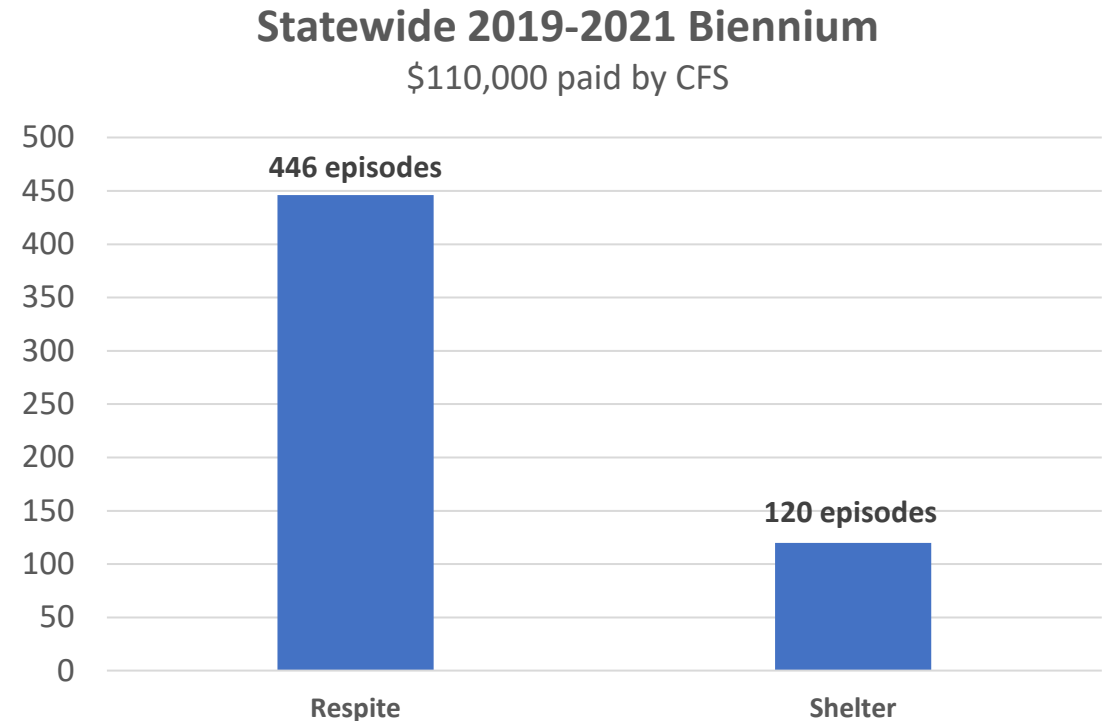

- ✓ Licensed family foster homes

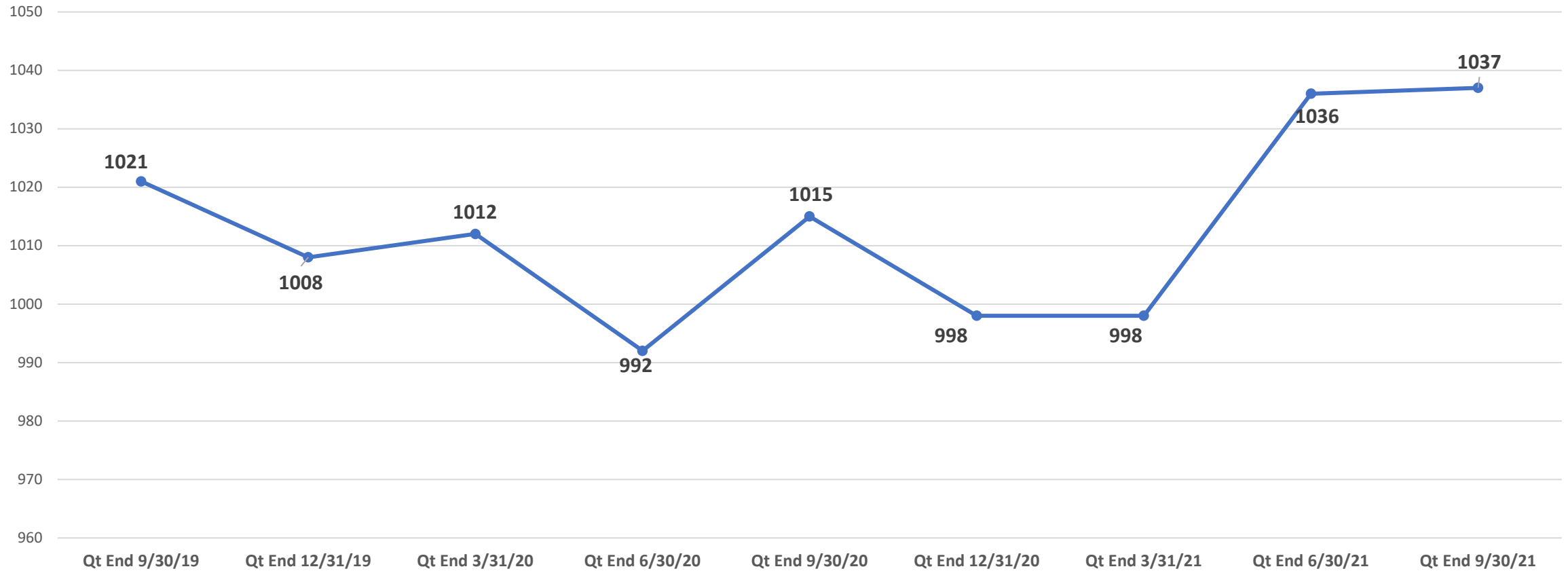
## Respite Care

- ✓ Contracted vendor agency



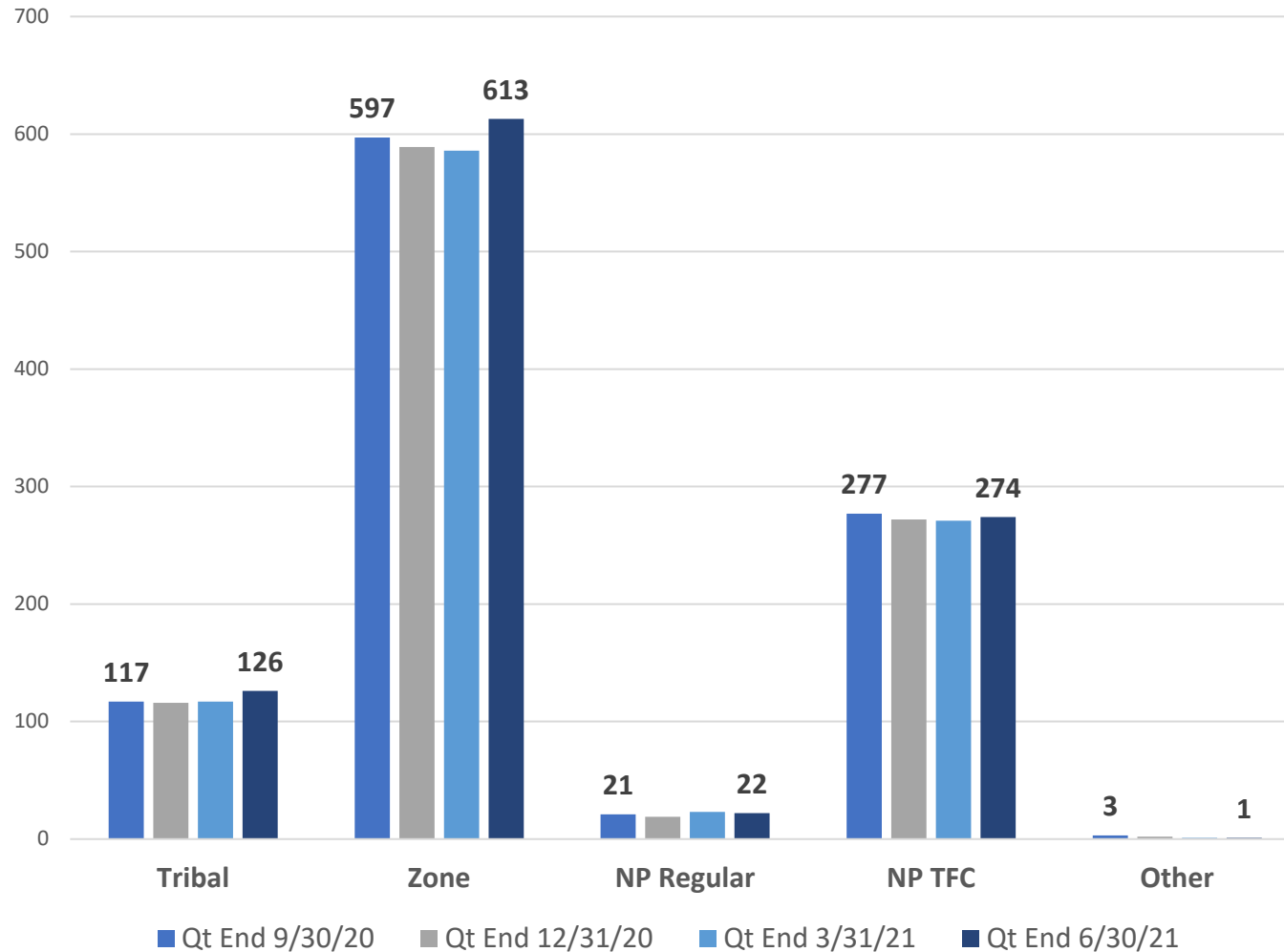
# Licensed Family Foster Homes

## North Dakota Licensed Foster Homes

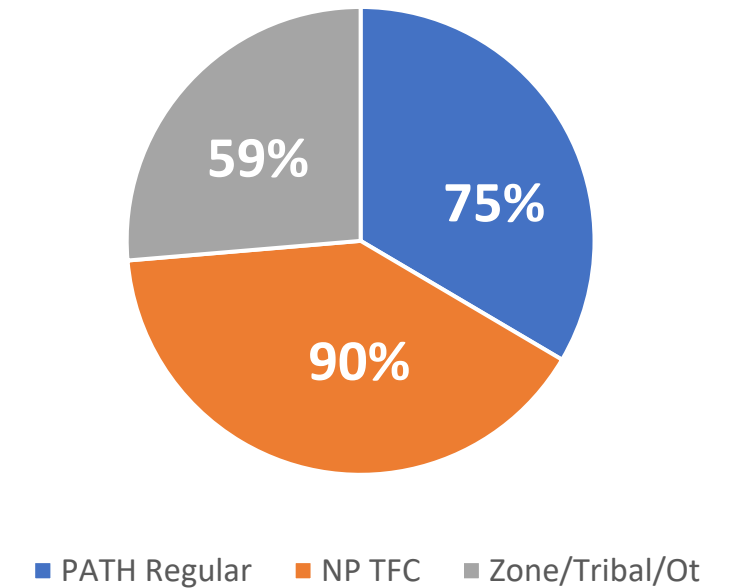


# Family Foster Homes

## Breakdown of Provider Type Totals

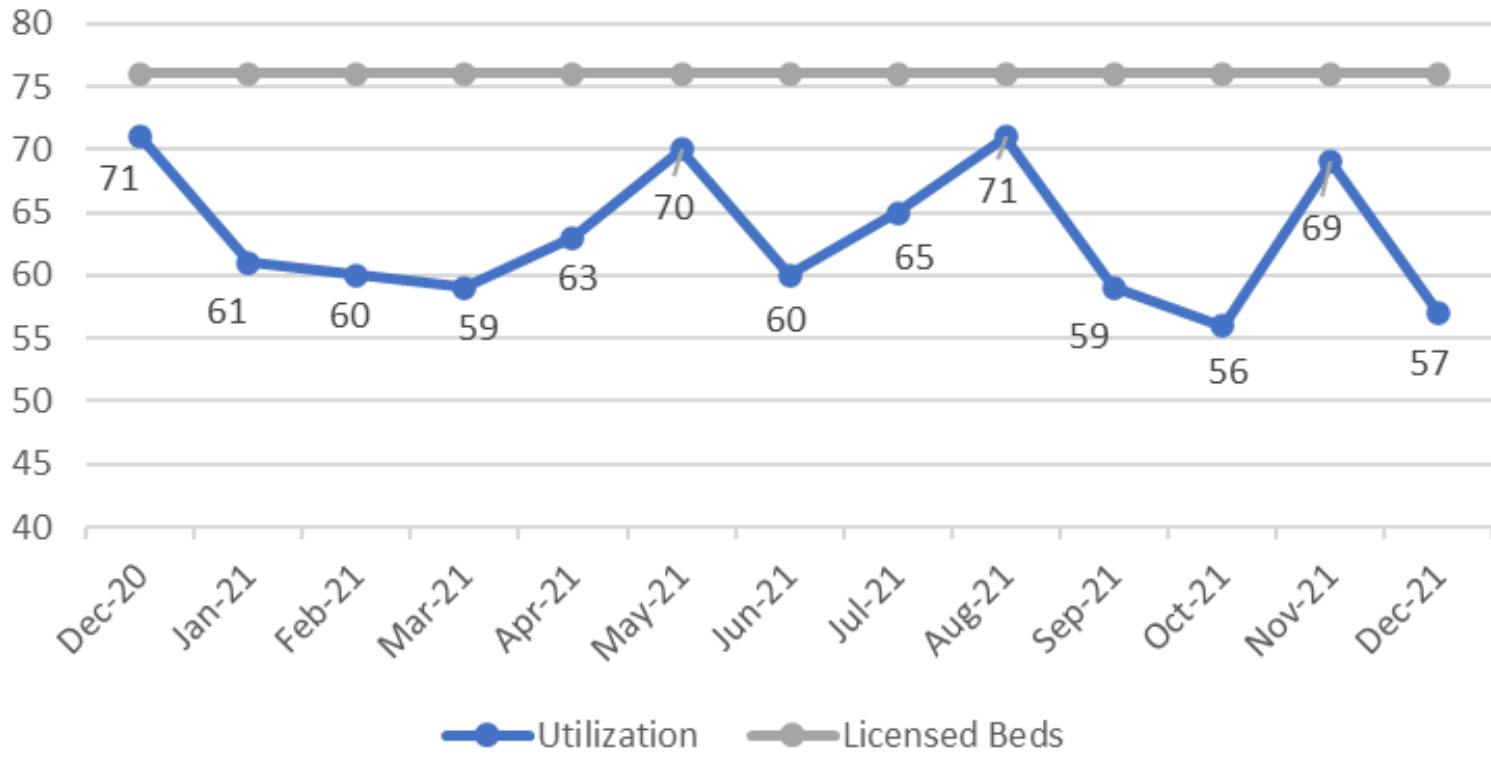


## Provider Utilization/Occupancy Average
