The Legal Advisory Unit will no longer issue signed findings and order when an individual chooses to sign either Waiver A, Waiver B or when there is a court conviction. The purpose of the findings and order is for the Executive Director of the Department to issue a final decision for an administrative hearing. When a waiver is signed or there is a court conviction, there is no administrative hearing.

Counties must continue to send in the signed waivers and court convictions to the Appeals Supervisor in the legal advisory unit. Policy administrators will

review these documents and provide a response to counties with the date and information to impose the disqualification.
