

**Service Chapter:** Basic Care Program 400-29, NonACA Medicaid 510-05

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2024

### **Overview**

To reflect rate changes for all licensed Basic Care facilities. For those nursing facilities that provide basic care services, it will be necessary to find out whether the individual is receiving nursing care or basic care services to determine the appropriate living arrangement and budgeting.

5. Except in determining eligibility for the Medicare Savings Programs, the cost of remedial care for an individual residing in a specialized facility is limited to the difference between the recipient's cost of care at the facility (e.g. remedial rate in a basic care facility) and the regular medically needy income level may be deducted.

**Example:**

Recipient's remedial rate at the facility	\$980 1438
Less the medically needy income level for one	<u>- \$834 1130</u>
Remedial care deduction	\$146 308
