**TOPIC: GREENWAY STRATEGIES - PRESCHOOL DEVELOPMENT GRANT
(PDG) ACTIVITIES**

Martha presented charts on what has transpired to date in the strategies/focus/and action steps.

To this point, Part C specifics did not emerge. During the needs assessment there was a lot of discussion. Martha stated that in the next steps, they will identify work current going on so that we align with that.

There was also comments that there is little in this for the framework about children with special health care needs; what information did they receive about these needs; and what about individual screening and surveillance. Martha responded that they continue to integrate and discuss the special needs services within the next phases. They will also be working with the inter-departments, Governor's Office, and other groups to develop high level initiatives and align with what is already happening and develop performance indicators for the goals. This work will be completed by the end of February 2020, and

then that goes back to the Federal government. Then it comes back to the state to address what the state will do to support this Strategic Plan. This depends on the implementation grant the state applied for. If this isn't available, the state will need to have discussion regarding available resources. It was stated that 14 states have received their award letter. Phones are going out yesterday, today, and tomorrow notifying states of their award. Not sure if DHS or DOH will be contacted.
