

Summer P-EBT



The North Dakota Department of Human Services, the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction and the USDA, Food and Nutrition Services have partnered to offer a Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) Program. The P-EBT program will help families with the cost of food for children during the summer months.

Who Qualifies?

Children ages 0-5 who have received SNAP benefits or are currently receiving SNAP benefits:

- The P-EBT benefit amount is based on the number of months children received SNAP benefits from September 2021 through July 2022.
- The total benefit amount will range from \$20 to \$571 and will be deposited as a one-time issuance to your household's SNAP EBT card.

School-aged children who are eligible for free or reduced-priced meals during the 2021/2022 School Year, or become newly eligible for free/reduced-priced meals during the summer months:

- The P-EBT benefit amount will be a one-time issuance of \$391.
- New P-EBT cards will be sent out to each eligible child.
- **Note:** Please allow through August 9, 2022 for new P-EBT cards due to processing and mailing time.

New to the EBT card? Here's what you need to know:

- Activation instructions will be included with the card.
- Cards are accepted at SNAP authorized food retailers. A list of authorized food retailers can be found at <https://www.fns.usda.gov/snap/retailer-locator>.
- A mobile app for managing your account, ebtEDGE, is available Apple Store and Google Play.
