### ► MEDICAID

Medicaid provides medical, dental and vision coverage for eligible children and adults.

Your child may be eligible if you qualify for other federal assistance programs.

Coverage includes:

- Routine doctor care
- Hospitalization
- Immunizations
- Mental health and substance abuse services
- Prescription drugs
- Vision services
- Dental care

### ► CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (CHIP)

Each state has a different name for its Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). In North Dakota, the program is called Healthy Steps. It's for children up to 19 years old who do not qualify for Medicaid.

Coverage includes:

- Routine doctor care
- Hospitalization
- Immunizations
- Mental health and substance abuse services
- Prescription drugs
- Vision services
- Dental care / Orthodontia
