(3) **ECMS**

- Mandatory ECMS meetings will be held monthly. Central office staff that work at NDYCC are strongly encouraged to attend monthly meetings as well.
- Any other training that is scheduled for ALL staff regarding ECMS.

#### **The minimum number of training hours typically required per training year is as follows:**

Support employees with minimal contact with juveniles	16 hours
Support employees with daily contact with juveniles	40 hours
Administrative, management, JCICMs, JIRS, and Treatment Specialists	40 hours
