Education is the root of American life. However, 21 percent of American adults are illiterate. The science of reading represents over five decades of multi-disciplinary research grounded in the neuroscience of how children learn to read. This session will provide an overview of evidence-aligned literacy instruction with a focus on dyslexia.
