

## **Dyslexia Screener MIS01 Report Guidance**

According to NDCC 15.1-32-26, each LEA (district) must

- 1. Provide a universal screener for dyslexia for enrolled children seven years of age and younger.
  - The person submitting this report will indicate whether the district provides a screener (yes/no) and select the assessment name from the dropdown list or enter an assessment title in the "other" box.
- 2. LEAs must provide a universal dyslexia screener upon request by a parent, legal guardian, or teacher.
  - The person submitting this report will indicate yes/no to the district's response to dyslexia screening requests.
- Each LEA must have processes to evaluate dyslexia risk factors, provide intervention services to students with dyslexia characteristics, and administer assessments to monitor the effectiveness of the services.
  - The person submitting this report will indicate yes/no to the district's processes related to students with dyslexia characteristics.
