

Framework: Foreign Language Instruction Pilot Program

Objective

To enhance early childhood education in North Dakota by supporting schools that provide foreign language instruction in grades K–3 through limited-time financial grants.

Program Duration

• **Start**: 2025–2026 School Year

• **End**: 2026–2027 School Year (2-year pilot)

Eligible Participants

- Public and private schools in North Dakota
- Must offer foreign language instruction to students in Kindergarten through
 Grade 3

Grant Funding

- Up to \$2,500 per school per year
- **Total funds appropriated**: \$49,500 for the 2025–2027 biennium
- Use of Funds:
 - Hiring or supplementing salaries of foreign language teachers (stipends)
 - Purchasing curriculum and instructional materials
 - Covering other program-related costs

Application & Participation Requirements

To be developed by the **North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI)**. Recommended elements may include:

- 1. Program plan (language offered, instructional time, curriculum description)
- 2. Implementation timeline
- 3. Budget allocation (how funds will be used)
- 4. Teacher qualifications
- 5. Reporting requirements (annual program impact report)
