Purpose of the Pilot

Support individualized mathematics learning for grades 4-8

Implement skill-level screening and assessment tools

Identify student needs and monitor multi-year progress

Provide actionable data to improve math learning outcomes statewide



Program Overview

Pilot Period: January 2026-June 2027

Districts/Schools selected through competitive application

Applications open **November 24-December 5, 2025**

Awards announced **December 12, 2025**



Funding Overview

Total Available: up to \$300,000 statewide

Grant range: \$25,000-\$100,000 per district/school

Allowable uses:

- Student software licenses
- Teacher professional development
- Implementation supports (e.g. coaching, integration, evaluation)



District/School Expectations

Participating Districts/Schools will:

- Implement a screening & intervention program from the approved list (2025-2027)
- Participate in vendor-provided professional learning and support sessions
- Collect and share district/school progress and implementation data (individual student data will remain private)
- Administer NDA+ interim and summative assessments
- Provide feedback to guide statewide decisions



Data & Reporting

Participating Districts/Schools will collect:

- Screening & progress monitoring data
- Student usage, participation, and outcomes
- Teacher implementation & professional learning data
- Feedback on usability and impact

**All student data will remain private; impact data is required to be shared with the 70th (2027) and 71st (2029) Legislative Assemblies



Eligibility & Application

Open to all ND public and non-public schools/districts serving grades 4-8

- Districts may include multiple schools
- Applications evaluated on:
 - Alignment with pilot goals
 - Implementation readiness
 - Effective funding use
 - Commitment to data-driven instruction
