

Need a little help feeding your kids when school is out for summer?

Learn how the Summer EBT program can help you!

Summer EBT is a new program to help families buy food for their school-aged children during the summer. Families will get \$120 for each eligible child to buy groceries during the summer. Children who get Summer EBT can still participate in other summer meal programs. Receiving Summer EBT will not affect children's or families' immigration status

How does Summer EBT work?

In North Dakota Summer EBT will be loaded onto an EBT card and mailed to each eligible child at the address registered with the child's school. If eligible, you can use Summer EBT benefits to buy food like fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains, and dairy at grocery stores, farmers' markets, and other places that accept SNAP EBT benefits. Summer EBT is a convenient way for you to help your children thrive.

Is my child eligible for Summer EBT?

Your child is eligible for Summer EBT if:

- Your household already participates SNAP, FDPIR, or TANF, OR
- Your child attends a school that offers the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Program, <u>and</u> your household income meets the requirements for federal free or reduced-price school meals.

Update your address by emailing ndsebt@nd.gov to ensure your Summer EBT benefits are sent to the correct address! Be sure to include the names of all school-aged children.





How do I enroll my child in Summer EBT?

Many families will get Summer EBT automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply for the program.

Many families that are automatically enrolled received an e-mail with a unique link to their child(ren)'s information in the North Dakota Summer EBT portal where they can change their address and check on their benefit status. Families without emails registered at their child's school did not get a link. They can contact ndsebt@nd.gov to see if they are eligible.

Children who are automatically enrolled will be mailed a Summer EBT card to the address registered with their school. If the address is not correct you can send your updated information to ndsebt@nd.gov.

If you are not automatically enrolled and believe your children are eligible, you can apply for Summer EBT by filling out a simple form.

When applying, you will be asked to provide your child's name, school, date of birth, and address. You will also be asked to report your household income. You will not need to provide any other documents or information to apply.
