

SFA Accommodation Plan SY 2025-2026

The USDA Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has implemented the first threshold limit for non-domestic food purchases to begin in SY 2025-2026. Non-domestic food purchases by the SFAs cannot exceed the annual threshold, which for SY 2025-2026 is 10 percent of total commercial food expenditures. This is intended to shift more purchases to domestic products (<u>7 CFR 210.21(d)(5)(ii)(A)</u> and <u>7 CFR 220.16(d)(5)(ii)(A)</u>).

For SFAs who have found that they will exceed the 10% limit this year, accommodation is available upon request. Use the following form for the request.

Reminder:

- This is not an exemption from completing the Buy American Justification worksheet required for non-domestic purchases that are not on the <u>FAR 25.104 list</u>.
- It also does not exempt the SFA from tracking ALL non domestic purchases: <u>Buy</u> American Tracking Tool

By completing this 3-question form, the SFA requests an accommodation for SY25-26 that allows them to exceed the 10 percent threshold, upon approval from the state agency.
