preparation program addressing the entity's capacity for having the program.		
Budget	1-20	
The budget should be clear on what amount is for student tuition and what is		
for program funding. Priority will be given to proposals focusing on student		
scholarships or tuition assistance.		
Sustainability	1 – 20	
The proposal must have a sustainability plan. All activities and budget
