

2023 LEARNING LOSS REPORT FAQs

WHICH ESSER GRANTS DOES THIS REPORT COVER?

The Learning Loss Report is a report inclusive of all ESSER grants as a whole. The report is targeted towards reporting on the use and impact of the funds versus a detailed focus on specific spending strategies.

WHAT NAME SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE REPORT?

The title of this report is not critical. A suggested title is “2023 Legislative Learning Loss Report”

WHAT DATES DOES THE 2023 LEARNING LOSS REPORT COVER?

The dates for the Learning Loss Report are less critical than they are for other reports as this report is inclusive from the start of the ESSER grants until September 30, 2023. The suggested dates for this report are as follows:

- Logistical date: October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023.
- Report on **expenditures** from the start of the first ESSER grant until September 30, 2023. Add expenditures not previously reported to this year's report.
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RARE**WHAT IF OUR SCHOOL DISTRICT REPORTED 100% OF FUNDS EXPENDED ON THE 2022 LEARNING LOSS REPORT?

If the school district expended 100% of ALL ESSER Grants before 9/30/22 an **abbreviated report** is still required to update the district data and follow-up on growth related to ESSER expenditures. Please provide updates on subgroups, changes in learning gaps, and any additional impacts realized since the 2022 Learning Loss report. They may skip questions related to spending amounts rather than re-report on previously reported funds.
