


## Choice Ready Summary Data 2018-2019 - Schools

North Dakota reported out on the Choice Ready results for the first time in September 2019, as we now have two years of data to be able to calculate growth for all North Dakota public high schools.

The Choice Ready results were included on the School Accountability report, which is represented by a graphic showing growth, as indicated below:



The Choice Ready measure is calculated based upon year-over-year growth in the overall performance of the school's graduating class having acquired the Essential Skills and attained the readiness areas of Post-Secondary, Workforce, and/or Military/Life Skills within the framework. High schools must improve year after year to maintain the Choice Ready goals as established within North Dakota's accountability initiatives.

Only overall growth was reported on the School Accountability Reports. However, additional Choice Ready data will be reported on the Insights dashboard. Schools graduating less than 10 students will have this data suppressed.
