2021-2022 ACCOUNTABILITY RELEASE

PURPOSE OF PRESENTATION The purpose of this presentation is to share the most recent Choice Ready data from the 2021-2022 school year.

CHOICE READY GROWTH

Choice Ready growth is calculated based upon yearover-year growth in the overall performance of the school's 12th grade students having acquired the **Essential Skills and attained** two of the three readiness areas consisting of Post-Secondary, Workforce, and/or Military/Life Skills within the framework.



| Percentage of points | Criteria (Year-over-Year Growth or Percentage of CR Students) | Points |
|----------------------|---|--------|
| 100% of points | 10.00% or more greater than the previous year or 90% of students are Choice Ready | 129 |
| 75% of points | 7.50% - 9.99% greater than the previous year or 75% of students are Choice Ready | 96.75 |
| 50% of points | 5.00% - 7.49% greater than the previous year or 50% of students are Choice Ready | 64.5 |
| 25% of points | 0.01% - 4.99% greater than the previous year or 25% of students are Choice Ready | 32.25 |
| 0 points | 0 growth or negative growth or 0% of students are Choice Ready | 0 |
