

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EXAMS

- External Assessment- summative examination at the end of a course
 - Scored 1-7
- Internal Assessment- project in which student demonstrates content knowledge
 - Scored 1-7

IB EXAM SCORING

- Score of 1-7

- 7= thorough knowledge
- 6= broad knowledge
- 5= good knowledge
- 4= satisfactory knowledge
- 3= partial knowledge
- 2= limited knowledge
- 1= minimal knowledge

- 4 or better is required to meet choice ready

10TH GRADE PERSONAL PROJECT

- Middle Years Program (MYP) serves IB students ages 11-16
- The 10th Grade Personal Project is a “capstone project” for students completing the MYP

IB DIPLOMA PROGRAM

- To earn an IB Diploma, students must complete the following:

- 1. Creativity, activity, and service activities (not assessed)
- 2. Theory of Knowledge assessment and presentation (1600 word essay)
- 3. Extended Essay (4000 word reflection paper)
- 4. Complete six IB Courses
 - Language and literature, language acquisition, individuals and societies, math, science, the arts
 - Earn a minimum of 24 points based on grades (1-7) in each course
