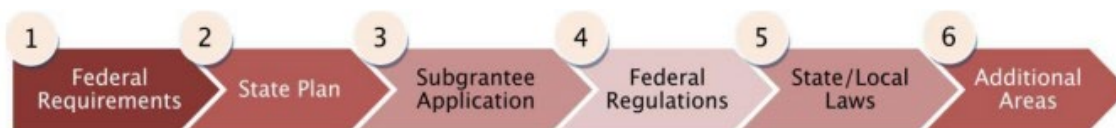


Decision Rule Steps for Allowable and Appropriate Uses of Funds



For each step, refer to the information listed in the Uses of Funds Chart below:

Step	Response
Does the proposed use(s) comply with Federal requirements regarding the use of TIPD funds (Subpart I or II)? • Subpart 1: Statute and nonregulatory guidance • Subpart 2: Statute and nonregulatory guidance	YES or NO
Does the proposed use(s) align with the goals and objectives of the TIPD portion of the North Dakota State Plan?	YES or NO
Does the proposed use(s) align with the requirements for and the needs expressed (through the needs assessment) in the subgrantee application (Subpart II)	YES or NO
