

Teacher Effectiveness Reporting Guidance

The 2024-2025 Teacher Effectiveness Report is due June 30, 2025.

All teacher evaluations must be completed by April 15 per North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) 15.1-15-01.

States must report on effective/ineffective teachers under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

North Dakota created a process to calculate an ineffective teacher equivalent to determine the number of ineffective teachers within a school. Rather than identify effective/ineffective teachers, North Dakota decided to report on ineffective teaching. In each respective evaluation tool, a teacher is considered ineffective within a specific element/component in which the teacher is rated a Level One (or zero).

Note: Schools can pick how many elements they evaluate their teachers on.




Select the current school year from the 'School Year' dropdown

Select the Teacher Evaluation model from the dropdown


If the model you use is not listed, select 'Other' and enter the model in the 'Other'; text field
