

State Report for Title IV -A Funds

Title IV - A, also known as Student Support and Academic Enrichment (SSAE), is part of the Every Student Succeeds Act reauthorization of the ESEA. The SSAE program is intended to improve students' academic achievement by increasing the capacity of state educational agencies (SEAs), local educational agencies (LEAs), and local communities to provide all students with:

- Access to a well-rounded education
- Improve school conditions for student learning, safe and healthy students
- Effective use of technology to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students

North Dakota (ND) used a formulary grant to ensure all eligible districts in ND that received Title I allocations in the previous school year received funding under Title IV - A. For the 2020-2021 school year, the minimum award for these Title IV-A grants in ND was \$10,000. Districts have the option to transfer their Title IV funds other Title Programs where they receive an allocation. Transferring of Title IV Funds is done based on the district's needs assessment and consultation with stakeholders to align funds with the district's priorities.

This table shows data on the number of LEAs who spent funds under Title IV, Part A of the ESEA by the content areas. The "Any" category reports the total number of LEAs that spent funds in any of the three content areas.

School Accountability through Strategic Planning
