Safe and Healthy	Provide students access to school-based health and mental services and resources by contracting with the Village to provide school-based therapy. Outcome: 9-month contact was secured, and a system was developed for referrals. 147 students/families accessed services.	Substantial measurable progress was made (50- 99%)
Well Rounded	Provide students access to school-based health and mental health services/resources. A school social worker was hired, and she was responsible for creating and implementing a Stay In School Program. Outcome: The program served 87 students/families; absences decreased with this group by 47% and the number of students failing courses also decreased in this group by 23%.	Some measurable progress was made (26- 49%)
Well Rounded	Provide students with supplemental educational experiences: Establish and provide student clubs: STEM, Robotics, Chess, Art, Music, Photography, and Latin. Students were surveyed and the desired clubs were Robotics, Art, Music, and Photography. Outcome: These clubs were established and well attended. Satisfaction surveys were given at the end of each semester showing an overall satisfaction rate of 94%. Overall attendance for the clubs was 89%.	Outcomes were met (100%)

Measures of Progress are defined as follows: Minimal measurable progress was made. (0-25%), Some measurable progress was made. (26-49%), Substantial measurable progress was made. (50-99%), and Outcomes were met. (100%)
