7/1/2022 – 6/30/2023 SCHOOL YEAR DISPUTE RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Three requests for *IEP Facilitation* were received:

- Two requests resulted in the successful completion of the IEP.
- One request resulted in the parent not wanting to facilitate, as the Request for Mediation resolved the issue.

Five requests for *Mediation* were received:

- One request resulted in the parties signing a Mediation Agreement.
- One request resulted in the district choosing not to participate in mediation but instead filing a Request for a Facilitation Meeting.
- One request resulted in a mediation meeting with the completion of a partial Mediation Agreement.
- One request did not result in a mediation meeting. The parties disagreed with the individual identified on the district's mediation request.
- One request resulted in an informal agreement.

Ten requests for *Complaint Investigation* were received:

- Four requests met the criteria, and an investigation was completed.
- Two requests did not meet the requirements for filing an IDEA Complaint and were forwarded to OCR.
- One* request met the criteria and is currently being investigated (the outcome of the allegations will be reported in the 2023-2024 Annual Report).
- One request resulted in the parent submitting a Request for a Systemic Complaint Investigation but later dismissed the request and filed a Due Process Complaint Notice.
- One complaint request was also filed as a *Due Process Complaint Notice*. The parent later withdrew the *Request for Complaint Investigation* as the due process proceedings resolved the allegations.
- One complaint filed did not state the allegations & violations. The parent did not resubmit the needed requirements for filing a *Request for Complaint Investigation*.

Three requests for *Due Process Complaint Notice* were received:

- Two requests resulted in a decision for the district.
- One request resulted in the parties reaching a resolution and a Settlement Agreement was executed.
