## DISPUTE RESOLUTION SUMMARY JULY 1, 2024– JUNE 30, 2025

### Seven requests for **IEP Facilitation** were received:

- One request, the district chose not to participate in facilitation.
- One request, the parent chose not to participate in facilitation.
- One request resulted in the student being on a 504 Plan.
- One request, the district met with the parents and resolved the issues without facilitation.
- One request resulted in the parent withdrawing the FIEP request.
- One request the team met, but it did not result in the successful completion of the IEP.
- One facilitation did not occur because the parent revoked special education services and decided to homeschool their child.

### Seven requests for **Mediation** were received:

- Three requests resulted in the parties signing a Mediation Agreement.
- Two requests the parties withdrew the Mediation Requests
- One request did not result in the parties signing a Mediation Agreement.
- One request resulted in NDDPI informing the parents to file the mediation request with the OCR.

### Fifteen requests for **Complaint Investigation** were received:

- Seven requests met the criteria, and an investigation was completed.
  - \*One request was filed in the 2023-2024 school year, but the outcome is reported in the 2024-2025 school year or this federal reporting period.
- One complaint request resulted in the parent withdrawing the *Request for Complaint Investigation*.
- Two complaint requests did not meet the requirements for filing a complaint, and the parent was offered the option to resubmit.
- Four complaint **requests** did not **meet** the requirements for filing a complaint, and the parent was referred to the USDE or OCR.
- \*One request met the criteria and is currently being investigated (the outcome of the allegation will be reported in the 2025-2026 Annual Report).

- No **Due Process Complaint Notices** were received during the July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025, reporting period.
