

K-3 Student Performance Strategist Guidelines

NDCC 15.1-07-32. Student performance strategist - Verification - Qualifications.

Beginning with the 2010-2011 school year, each school district must have available one full-time equivalent student performance strategist for every four hundred students in average daily membership in kindergarten through grade three. Each school district shall submit documentation to the superintendent of public instruction, at the time and in the manner directed by the superintendent, verifying the amount of time that each student performance strategist expended in tutoring students on a one-to-one basis or in groups ranging from two to five, or in providing instructional coaching to teachers. For purposes of this section, a "student performance strategist" must meet the qualifications of an elementary school teacher as set forth in section 15.1-18-07 and serve as a tutor or an instructional coach.

All schools are required to report teaching staff on the MIS03 form in STARS the fall of each school year. The MIS03 coding requirements for the state funded student performance strategist are below:

Reporting for the Student Performance Strategist actual worktime is completed through the Spring Calendar on STARS. In this report, the district will indicate the staff fulfilling the student performance strategist position, the amount of time (total minutes per year) that each student performance strategist *provided services in one or more of the following areas*:

- tutoring students on a one-to-one basis,
- tutoring groups ranging from two to five, or
- providing instructional coaching to teachers.

The requirement for the Student Performance Strategist is state law; therefore, schools cannot use Title I paid staff to meet this requirement as that would be supplanting.
