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

# Seeing the forest, not the trees...

- Consider starting your work today with a quick review of the whole set of standards
- Look for:
  - How are they organized?
  - What are the major components?
  - Look at the entire grade span. Pick a few skills and see how the skill progressed
  - What are the major topics covered in the standards?

# Review Protocol

- Read and Reflect
- Unpack
  - Content
  - Cognitive Demand
  - Progression through grades – look at previous and next
- North Dakota Context
- Review/Revise/Rewrite
- Consensus
- Vote

# Editing Procedures

- Computer provided to each table
  - Official. All changes reflected on this computer
- Track changes using Word tools. Use track changes and the comments function
- Projector available so that the group can see proposed changes
- Obtain informal consensus on any proposed wording changes. Take an official vote on the final version of the standard
- Criteria: Can I live with the proposed standard?

# Committee

- Elect leader and official recorder
- Leader – responsible for keeping the process moving forward and making sure that consensus is obtained before moving forward
- Recorder – responsible for maintain the official copy of changes

- ND standards prior to Common Core
- Other state standards are available online.  
Keep in mind that only 4 states did not adopt the CCSS, so most states will be very similar to ND's!
