

North Dakota Title III Consortium/Co-op Agreement

Title III of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, reauthorized by the Every Student Succeeds Act provides supplemental funding for eligible districts or a consortium/co-op of eligible districts to help serve EL students. Districts that have students who qualify as EL must develop an appropriate EL program using state or local funds and therefore it is the district's responsibility to pay for an EL teacher. Title III funds are to provide supplemental resources for professional development, instructional materials for EL students, and possible paraprofessionals. Once the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) has the list of districts applying for Title III funding, we can determine the final allocation amounts available to each district/co-op.
